

THINGS TO CONSIDER WHEN VISITING A MASJID (MOSQUE)

- ◆ **VISITORS ARE ASKED TO DRESS MODESTLY.**
- ◆ **PLEASE COVER ARMS AND LEGS.**
- ◆ **EXAMPLES OF INAPPROPRIATE CLOTHING WOULD BE SHORTS FOR BOYS AND MEN, AND SHORT SKIRTS AND SKIMPY TOPS FOR GIRLS AND WOMEN.**
- ◆ **SHOES ARE ALWAYS LEFT AT THE ENTRANCE TO THE PRAYER AREA TO PREVENT SOILING OF RUGS AND CARPETS. (SHELVES ARE PROVIDED TO HOLD SHOES).**
- ◆ **WOMEN COVER THEIR HAIR IN THE PRAYER AREA. SCARVES ARE USUALLY ON HAND FOR VISITORS TO BORROW - BUT IT IS BETTER TO BRING A HEAD COVERING IN CASE NONE ARE AVAILABLE.**
- ◆ **VISITORS TO THE MASJID (MOSQUE) SHOULD BEHAVE AS THEY WOULD VISITING ANY RELIGIOUS INSTITUTION.**
- ◆ **VISITORS SHOULD FEEL FREE TO ASK QUESTIONS ABOUT THE MASJID (MOSQUE), ITS ARCHITECTURE, FURNISHINGS AND ACTIVITIES.**
- ◆ **MUSLIMS ARE HAPPY TO ANSWER QUESTIONS ABOUT THEIR RELIGION.**
- ◆ **PREPARING QUESTIONS TO ASK BEFORE HAND WOULD BE USEFUL.**
