ABLEISM – Prejudice, stereotyping, and discrimination directed against people who have developmental, emotional, physical, sensory, or health-related disabilities.



AGEISM – The cultural, institutional and individual set of practices and beliefs that assign different values to people according to their age.



CLASSISM – The cultural, institutional and individual set of practices and beliefs that assign value to people according to their socio-economic status.



FAITHISM – The cultural, institutional and individual set of practices and beliefs that assign different values to people according to their religion or creed, or their lack of religion or creed.



HOMOPHOBIA – A range of negative attitudes and feelings towards homosexuality.



RACISM – A set of erroneous assumptions, opinions, and actions stemming from the belief that one race is inherently superior to another.

SEXISM – Prejudice, stereotyping, and discrimination directed against people on the basis of their sex or gender.
